



Director of Emergency & Protective Services

Under the direction of the Chief Administrative Officer, the Director of Emergency and Protective Services will be responsible for the management of the Emergency Services and Municipal Enforcement departments. The incumbent will participate in a fire prevention program-enforcing National, Territorial and City fire regulations and orders from City Council pertaining to life safety as well as enforcement of by-laws. The successful candidate will take a key role in incident command of major incidents and investigations. Will set departmental goals, assess the training needs of staff and ensure policies and procedures are strictly adhered to. The Director will aid in the development and implantation of the Municipal Emergency Measures Plan. The incumbent recommends and implements multi-year capital work plans in conjunction with the overall budget, goals and objectives of City Council.

The successful candidate should have formal education to a level three Fire Officer, current Standard First Aid and CPR-C certifications. The incumbent must have a minimum of 5 years emergency services experience with at least 2 years in a supervisory role. Should also have knowledge of legal interpretations and municipal by-laws and acts to be enforced as well as medical knowledge. Must have proven leadership, negotiation and conflict resolutions skills. Excellent analytical, communication, written and interpersonal skills is required along with a Class 5 driver's license. Ability to communicate in Inuktitut is an asset.

Equivalencies that include a combination of education, knowledge, skills and abilities to formal education may be considered.
